Homework

Thankyou for your support in completing and returning homework. Book bags should be brought to school every morning and returned home every afternoon. This is to encourage organisational skills and allows children to carry homework, reading books, letters, first aid slips etc. in a neat and tidy fashion. Reading books etc can then be stored safely both at school and at home to avoid loss.

Homework is set on Thursday for all Lower KS2 classes.

There will be an English task, maths task, spellings to practise, times tables to practise and often a handwriting task.

Homework is an opportunity to practise and consolidate skills. Homework sent home is specific to your child's ability and therefore they should be able to complete work with minimum help from you. However your support would be appreciated, please encourage

your child to sit at a table if possible and avoid distractions, point out the importance of neatly presented work and encourage them to concentrate, do the work and then relax!

Children also bring home a book from the class library to read for enjoyment. This can be read to them by an adult or older sibling or they can read it themselves.

Trip

Our trip to Knowsley Safari Park is on Wednesday 28 June. Thankyou to everyone for the monies received so far. A final letter was sent out on Monday 5th June with the details for the day.

Please can we draw your attention to procedures for when we return from the trip. As parents, we know how frustrating it can be when you can see your child leave the coach and you are asked to wait whilst they enter school, only to leave with you by a different door.

The children's safety is our main concern and we are unable to check everyone leaves safely if children just leave in an adhoc fashion. The idea behind the system is that teachers know all children enter school after the trip and can monitor successfully who they go home with.

We appreciate your co-operation in this matter and we are more than willing to adapt procedures if any parent / carer has a different solution to this issue. We would value your contribution, please ask to speak to the class teacher or Mrs. Pazos to discuss any issues prior to the trip date.
